1. συνάποθνήσκω = To die together with someone  
(sunapothnesko) II Tim 2<sup>11</sup> (compare Rom 6<sup>8</sup> συν)
2. συσταυρόω = act, To crucify with, together; Pass. To be  
(sustaurōo) crucified with Rom 6<sup>6</sup>; Gal 2<sup>19</sup>
3. συνθάπτω = To bury with, together, at the same time  
(sonthapto) Rom 6<sup>4</sup>; Col 2<sup>12</sup>
4. συζωοποιέω = To make alive together with  
(suzoopoieō) Eph 2<sup>5</sup>; Col 2<sup>13</sup>
5. συνεγείρω = To assist someone in getting up;  
(sunegairo) To cause someone to rise up or wake up  
with another Eph 2<sup>6</sup>; Col 2<sup>12, 3</sup>
6. συζάω = To live together with someone  
(suzao) Rom 6<sup>8</sup>; II Tim 2<sup>11</sup>
7. συγκαθίζω = To set someone with someone  
(syngkathizo) Eph 2<sup>6</sup>
8. Per θ γινώσκω + συμφύτος = To grow together,  
(ginomai) (symphutos) belonging together,  
Rom 6<sup>5</sup> To be united with
9. συμπασχω = To suffer with I Cor 12<sup>26</sup>  
(sympascho) Rom 8<sup>17</sup>
10. συμμορφίζω = To confer the same form  
symmorphizo Phil 3<sup>10</sup>
